Public Consultation

Personally I feel our consultation day on Monday 16th May went well and provided the opportunity for those that wished to express their observations on the preparation of a Plan. Whilst I had hoped more people would attend I believe the numbers justified the purpose.

One to One Consultation

Arrangements are in hand for me to be available in the Pavilion between 10am and 12md on either Saturday 9th or 23rd July.

AVDC

AVDC requested a copy of the Questionnaire Analysis, a schedule of the proposed time scale for preparation of the Plan and a monthly report. As we are working for our Parish Council I consulted the Chair and Clerk prior to releasing the information. It was agreed and I have forwarded to AVDC a copy of the analysis and time scales. I pointed out to AVDC that presently the analysis should not be released outside the District Council without previous consultation with Stewkley. It was further agreed I will complete a monthly report to the Parish Council and they will then forward it on to AVDC Neighbourhood Planning Officer.

Adjoining Parishes

I have appointments to attend Drayton Parslow Parish Council on 27th June and Mursley PC on 4th July. A meeting with Cublington is being arranged. I await responses from other adjoining Parishes. Drayton Parslow are just about to start their Neighbourhood Plan.

AVDC District Plan

AVDC have a series of Public Consultation Days between 11th July and 10th August in order to hear more about their Draft District Plan. I plan to attend Newton Longville Village Hall on Wednesday 27th July and would be pleased to be accompanied.

I remind everyone the research of the Working Groups should be drawing to a close in six weeks time and they should be pulling together their results and recommendations to report to the Steering Group by 31st August.
