

RESULTS OF NOVEMBER 2017 PUBLIC SURVEY
ON THE NUMBER OF HOMES REQUIRED IN THE VILLAGE.

Following the 2-week consultation with residents on future housing proposals for Stewkley over the next 5, 10 & 15 years the results are as follows:

Option 1. Vale of Aylesbury District Plan (VALP) suggestion **101** new homes
This to be achieved by 67 at the Soulbury Road (Site 15),
14 at Cricketers Farm, 66 High Street North (Site 12) plus the 18 built or
planning granted since 2013 and two additional new homes at Griffin Field
(Site 53)

60 residents preferred this option.

Option 2. Proposal for **127** new homes to include as above plus developments
at Wing Road (Sites 20, 22,23 & 47 and Potash (Site 52).

64 residents preferred this option.

Option 3. Proposal for **150** new homes All sites identified during the Neighbourhood
Plan process and presented at July 2017 public consultation. Sites include all
those identified above and also include Sites, 1, 2, 3, 7 and 33.

66 residents preferred this option.

A total of 190 responses to the 'Your Choice' form were received within the voting period.

The result of the survey was discussed at the Neighbourhood Planning Steering
Group meeting on 20th November when it was noted that two thirds of the respondents
supported a Plan focussed on Stewkley's needs. Unanimous agreement was reached on the
decision to advise the Parish Council to proceed with Option 3 in the Neighbourhood Plan.
